The Panama's National A/G Church designated at no cost the LARTC property that is strategically located near Panama City's Tocumen International Airport.

Ministries, churches and individuals have sacrificially given large and small offerings that God has stretched to meet timely needs of phased construction.

Twelve church construction teams have given generously, purchased materials and invested thousands of volunteer man hours.

Vendors have discounted materials and our local construction crew have selflessly sacrificed, working extended hours to meet deadlines and even without wages when funds weren't available.

Our flexible use design and phased approach has allowed us to occupy and use facilities while building and without waste.

CONSTRUCTION AND MINISTRY MILESTONES

Following are some important milestones. Celebrate with us!

Nov. 2012 - Panama A/G Presbytery unanimously designates Rana de Oro property for the LARTC.

Fall 2015 - Creek is bridged, road extended, land cleared and leveled.

Feb. 2016 - Lincolnton, GA MAPS team launches construction.

Feb. 20, 2017 - Move-in day!

March 9, 2017 - Dedication of Phase 1 Training/Admin Building.

Aug. 2017 - First month-long Advanced training seminar.

Winter 2018 - Atrium roofed; Bakersfield begins construction.

Oct. 2018 - Miracle offering to complete the 2nd floor Housing building!

Feb. 2019 - 13 additional guestrooms completed.

March 2019 - International Dialogue occupies all 23 questrooms!

April 2019 - Atrium roof installed; Training addition started.

July 2019 - Atrium mezzanine/stairs completed, windows/doors installed; Commerical kitchen equipped.

Oct. 2019 - Training addition floors poured and exterior walls completed; Atrium construction completed.

Dec. 2019 - Atrium completed (except for A/C installation)!

Feb. 2020 - Atrium A/C installation begun.

Nov. 2020 to Jan. 2021 - Perimeter security wall and gate completed.

Feb. 2021 - Road and parking lot base laid and surfaced, parking lot lights.

Mar. to May 2021 - Roof facade/soffit built on front of building.


SO CLOSE! 98% COMPLETE!

Primary LARTC construction is now 98% complete! Following are the construction phases and timetable, represented visually to the right, beginning at the bottom with 0 and ending with E at the top that represents exterior work to be completed during the second half of construction.

- 4. Training Addition (2019-21)
- **3. Atrium** Lobby, Auditorium, Mezzanine (2019-20)
- 2. Housing, Kitchen (2017-19)
- 1. Training, Administration, Production (2016-17)
- 0. Road/ Culvert/ Site Prep/ Utilities (2014-15)

The chart to the right shows the percentage completed for each phase, square feet of building for phases 1-4 and the budget for each phase.

We are humbled to think that so many churches, individuals and ministries have now invested \$1.92 million in the LARTC project! Looking back strengthens our faith to look forward.

REMAINING WORK FOR 2021

Our goal is to complete **all work** by this fall! Work is divided into two areas. Following is a summary with budget estimates.

Exterior Work: \$15k funded \$40k additional needed

- -Building facade/soffits, enclose downspouts
- -Final painting
- -Landscaping
- -Secondary retaining walls

Phase 4 Training Addition: \$40k additional needed

- -Electrical and lights
- -Bathrooms and plumbing
- -Interior sheetrock walls
- -Doors
- -Suspended Ceilings
- -Air conditioning
- -Paint
